**DOCUMENTS (8)**

1. A PHOTOCOPY OF THE CITIZENSHIP **DECLARATION**. THE DECLARATION IS SUBMITTED AT THE MUNICIPALITY WHERE YOU RESIDE. YOU MUST HAVE **2 GREEK CITIZENS AS WITNESSES** AND THE DECLARATION MUST BE SIGNED IN FRONT OF THE MAYOR OR ANOTHER APPOINTED OFFICER
2. THE CITIZENSHIP **APPLICATION** ADDRESSED TO THE MINISTRY OF INTERIOR. THIS IS SUBMITTED TO THE REGIONAL CITIZENSHIP DIRECTORATE. THE APPLICATION MUST BE COMPLETED IN GREEK AND SIGNED
3. **A COLORED PHOTO**
4. **PHOTOCOPY OF DOCUMENTATION OF STATELESSNESS OR SPECIAL TRAVEL DOCUMENT (T.D.V.)**
5. BIRTH CERTIFICATE OFFICIALLY TRANSLATED AND CERTIFIED BY A GREEK CONSULATE\*. IF THIS IS NOT POSSIBLE, **THE STATELESSNESS CERTIFICATE IS ACCEPTED**. IF YOU WERE BORN IN GREECE, A GREEK BIRTH REGISTRATION CERTIFICATE IS ACCEPTED
6. **PHOTOCOPY OF YOUR 3 LAST TAX DECLARATIONS**
7. **SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBER (AMKA)**
8. **FEE (PARAVOLO) - 100€**

THE CODE FOR THE FEE CAN BE PRINTED FROM [www.gsis.gr](http://www.gsis.gr) OR FROM KEP AND THEN THE PAYMENT IS DONE AT THE BANK

\* The certificates should be officially translated from the Translation Service of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs **or** the Consular Service of the country of origin **or** from a Greek lawyer **or** from a translator graduate of the Ionian University School of Translation and **not from private offices.**
