

CITIZENSHIP

CHILDREN OF NATURALIZED FOREIGNERS

PREREQUISITES

The children of foreigners who are naturalized acquire Greek citizenship if they are:

- ✓ Minors
- ✔ Unmarried
- ✓ They reside permanently in the country for the last 2 years before their parent's acquisition of Greek citizenship

ATTENTION!

* If the child is less than two (2) years old, and was born in Greece, it means that he resides permanently in the country from the date of his birth onwards.

DOCUMENTS

The following supporting documents must be submitted to prove the permanent residence of minors and unmarried children in Greece:

- 1. CHILD'S VALID RESIDENCE TITLE IN THE COUNTRY
- 2. CHILD'S CERTIFICATES OF ATTENDANCE AT A SCHOOL IN GREECE
- 3. CHILD'S HEALTH BOOKLET
- 4. CHILD'S A.M.K.A.

ATTENTION!

In case the child was born abroad, the following must be presented:

- \checkmark National visa for entry into Greece for reasons of family reunification or
- ✓ His current residence permit in the country
