

## NATURALIZATION SUBSIDIARY PROTECTION OR HUMANITARIAN REASONS \*AFTER 7 YEARS OF LEGAL RESIDENCE\*

## **DOCUMENTS (9)**

- 1. **PHOTOCOPY OF THE CITIZENSHIP DECLARATION**. THIS DECLARATION IS SUBMITTED TO THE **MUNICIPALITY** OF YOUR PERMANENT RESIDENCE. IT SHOULD BE SIGNED IN FRONT OF YOU FROM THE MAYOR OR ANOTHER ASSIGNED OFFICER. YOU SHOULD HAVE **2 GREEK CITIZENS AS WITNESSES**
- 2. A CITIZENSHIP APPLICATION DIRECTED TO THE MINISTRY OF INTERIOR. IT SHOULD BE SUBMITTED TO THE REGIONAL CITIZENSHIP DIRECTORATE. IT SHOULD BE COMPLETED IN GREEK AND SIGNED
- 3. A RECENT COLORED PHOTO
- 4. PHOTOCOPYOF PASSPORT
- 5. PHOTOCOPY OF THE **SUBSIDIARY PROTECTION RESIDENCE PERMIT OR PROTECTION FOR HUMANITARIAN REASONS RESIDENCE PERMIT** OR THAT YOU ARE A FAMILY MEMBER OF A HOLDER OF EITHER OF THESE.
- 6. BIRTH CERTIFICATE OFFICIALLY TRANSLATED AND CERTIFIED BY A GREEK CONSULATE\*. IF YOU HAVE SUBSIDIARY PROTECTION, THE DECISION GRANTING THIS STATUS IS ACCEPTED. IF YOU WERE BORN IN GREECE, THE GREEK BIRTH REGISTRATION CERTIFICATEIS ACCEPTED
- 7. PHOTOCOPY OF YOUR **7 LAST TAX DECLARATIONS**
- 8. SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBER(AMKA)
- 9. **FEE (PARAVOLO) 550€**

\* The certificates should be officially translated from the Translation Service of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs or the Consular Service of the country of origin or from a Greek lawyer or from a translator graduate of the Ionian University School of Translation and not from private offices.
