Non-compulsory secondary education

Level 4 options

General High School for 15-18 years old (3 years duration)



Evening General High School for over 18 years old OR 16-18 years old employed

Intercultural High School for 15-18 years old (3 years duration)

University Bachelor programmes *Lev. 6* Technological bachelor programmes (TEI) *Lev. 6* Vocational training (IEK) *Lev. 5*

Day Vocational High School (ΕΠΑΛ) for over 15 years old (3 years duration)
= Equivalent High school diploma + Specialisation diploma Level 4 +Paid Apprenticeship

 5 Evening Vocational High School (ΕΠΑΛ) for over 15 yrs. old & must be employed (4 years duration)
= Equivalent High School Diploma + Specialisation diploma Level 4



5% of graduates enter University Bachelor programmes Lev. 6 University Professional Education Centres (KEE) Lev. 5 OAEA Apprenticeship Programme Lev. 4

20% of graduates can enter Technological Bachelor programmes (TEI) Lev. 6





Post-secondary education

Level 5

1. Vocational programmes (IEK) (2 years duration) + Exams to acquire Certification

> 2. Apprenticeship (1 year duration) + lessons

Level 6

1. University Bachelor programmes (4 years duration)

2. Technological bachelor programmes (4 years duration)

At the Municipality of Athens, there are different types of schools operating (Junior High School, High School as well as Vocational High School) with Reception classes specifically for migrants, asylum seekers and refugees. For more info: <u>info@g2red.org</u>

Documents needed

Exceptionally, according to paragraph 8, article 21 of law 4251/2014, minor third-country citizens (specifically, a) **recognized refugees**, b) people coming from places where there is a **turbulent situation**, c) **asylum seekers** and d) **third-country citizens** who reside in Greece but their legal residence in the country has not been regulated yet)

can submit insufficient documents for registration to public schools of all levels.

THE FOLLOWING DOCUMENTS ARE AT LEAST NEEDED: • proof of address • a solemn declaration stating years of attending school abroad • a photocopy of residence permit.
