ACTIVITIES HAVE BEGAN!

Aiming to promote youth employability by providing capacity building, training, and tools to youth workers who work with young people with fewer opportunities, the project **SIDE** will, among others, create training modules, essential for all youth workers. The first phase, for the creation of the modules has already been concluded in national level, since all 6 partners implemented Focus Groups in Italy, Spain and Greece in order to gather data from professionals.

The Focus Groups' findings were quite interesting and the combination of data from three different countries draws a detailed image of the difficulties, the challenges but also the needs of Youth Workers. Working with young people with some kind of vulnerability, be it social, economic, or health related can be quite difficult. Capacity building and most importantly self-recognition of skills and capacities are essential for a person to feel empowered and able to conquer a stable and prosperous career. This is our goal, to empower all youngsters that are in danger of being left outside the job market and consequently society.

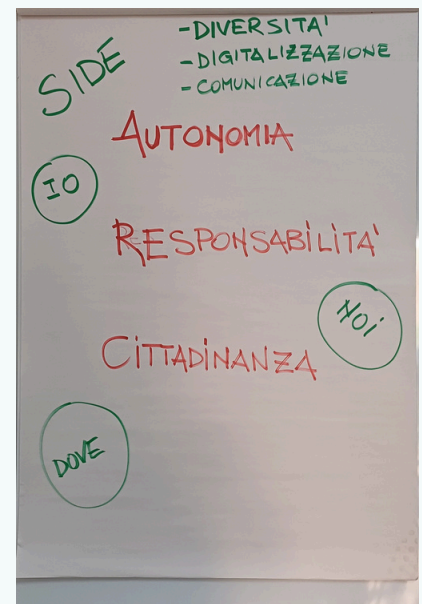
AHORA ONG

GENERATION 2.0 FOR RIGHTS, EQUALITY & DIVERSITY

Professionals with great experience in consulting and empowering youngsters, described all the challenges they face when they deal with vulnerable identities, and each case must be treated differently. But overall, what is clear is that social inclusion is the factor to overcome any vulnerability.
